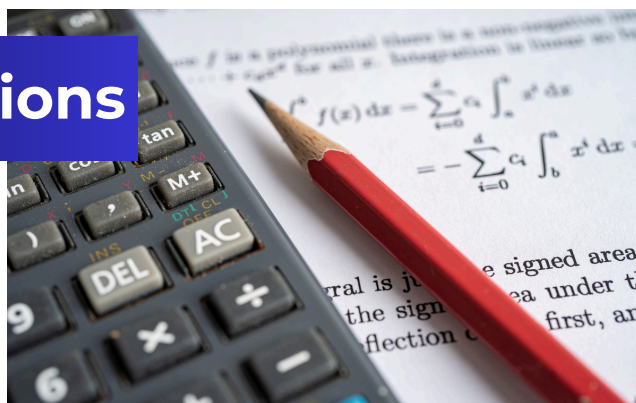


Labour Day

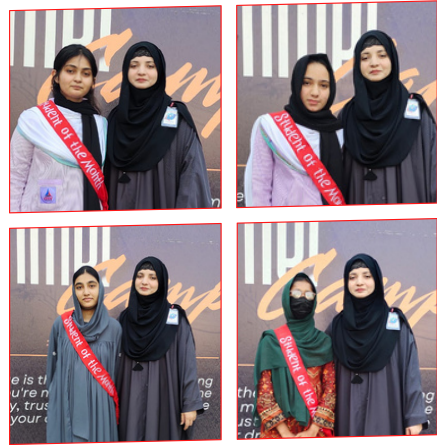


First Monthly Test in Summer Camp
